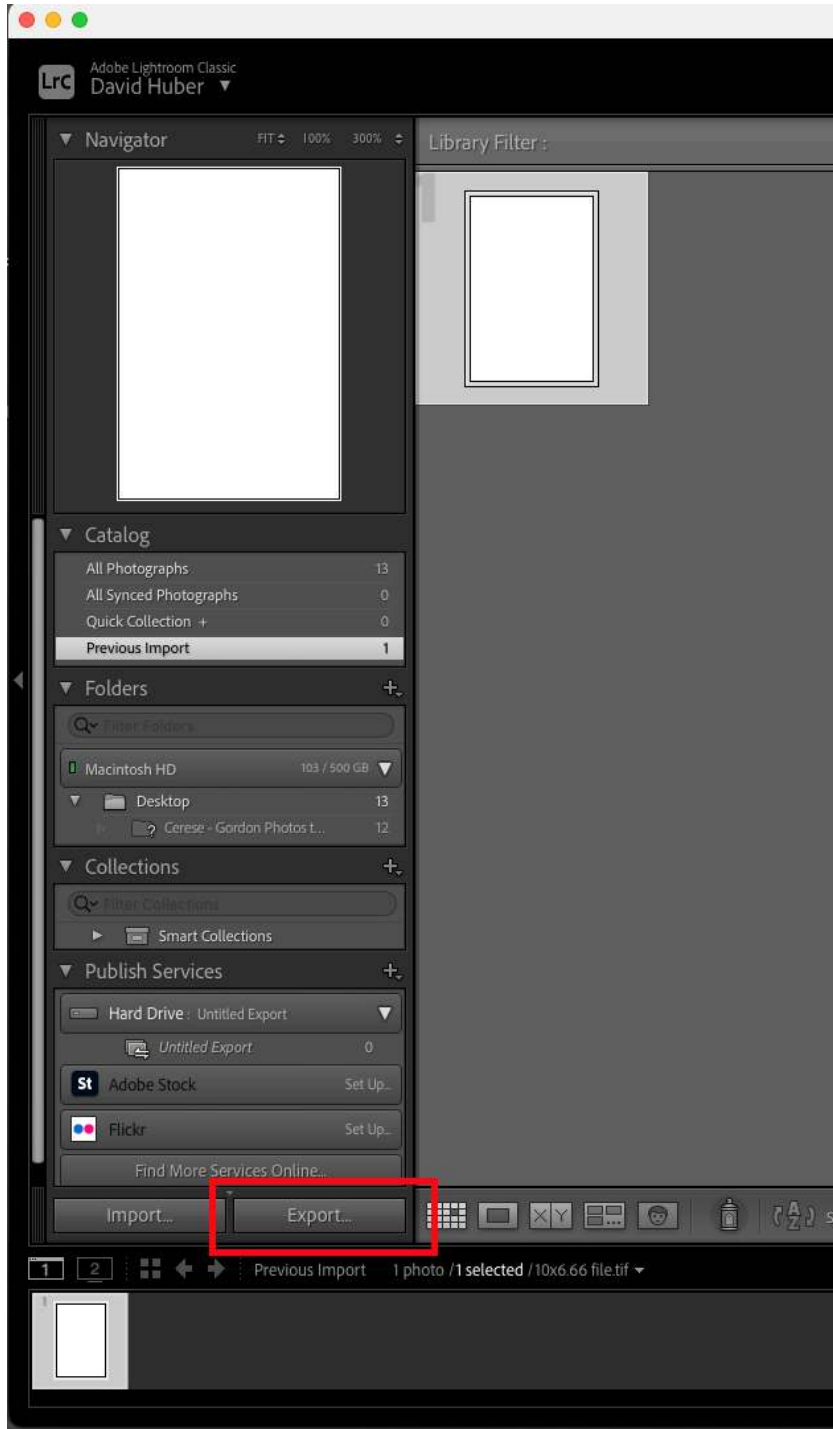


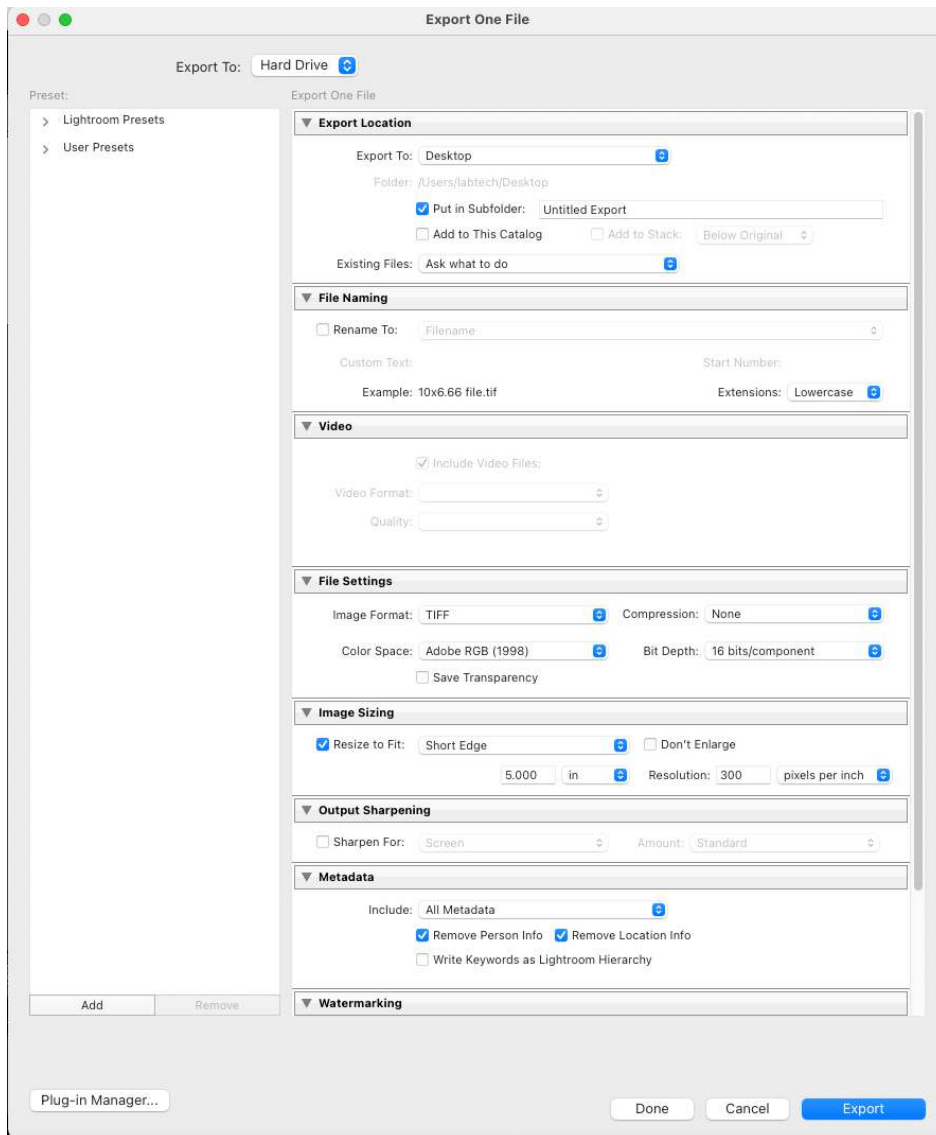
Lightroom Classic

Exporting Files

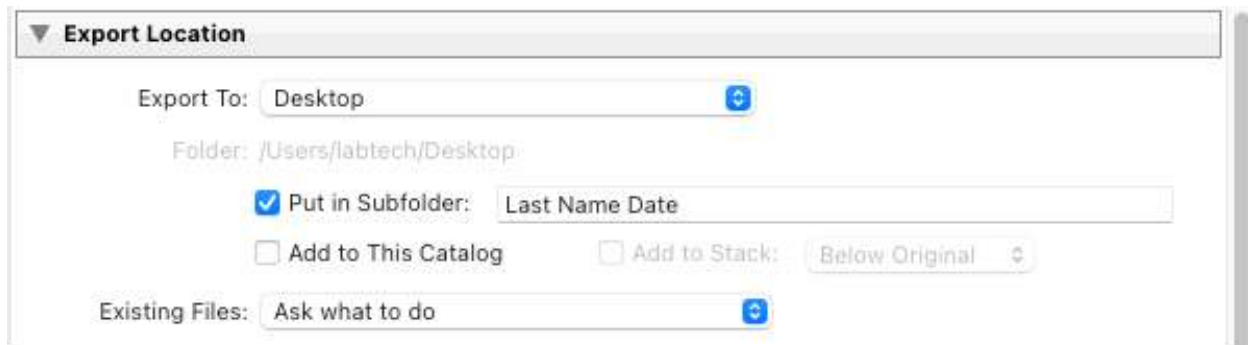
These are instructions for Lightroom Classic, not Lightroom.



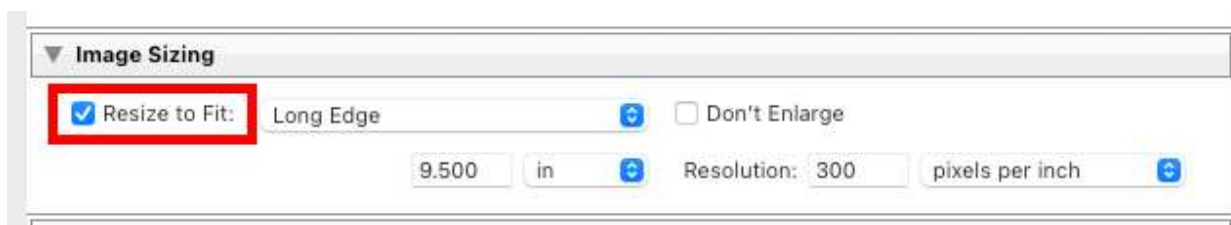
Select images you want to export and press the Export button in the lower left.



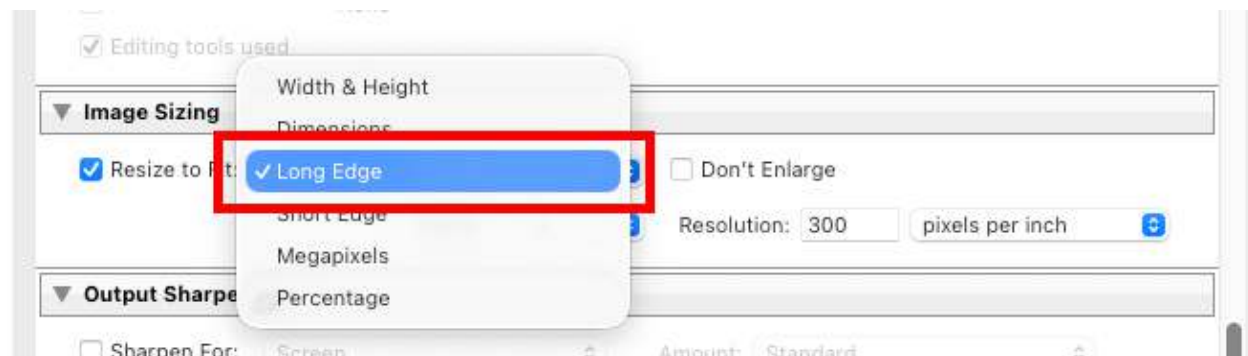
There are a lot of export settings, but the important ones are:
Export Location and Image Sizing



Select where you would like to export the files to and give the folder a name.
You can name the folder with your last name and date for easier submission of files to the Digital Print Studio.



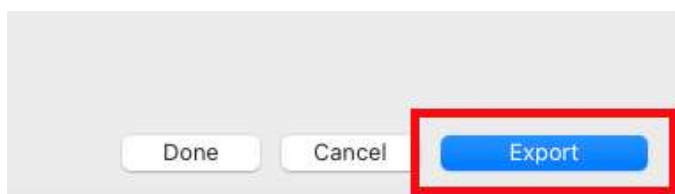
Make sure the check “resize to fit” under image sizing. This will resize your images to your desired settings in this box.



You have several options, but the “Long Edge” is the most common. The long edge option will allow for the same sizing in either portrait or landscape oriented images. Which is much more flexible than the width & height setting.



Set your desired long edge size.
Make sure the resolution is at 300, which is print resolution.



Then press Export in the lower right corner of that setting menu.
